**ORDER DIRECTING THE  
APPOINTMENT OF A CHAPTER 11 TRUSTEE**


Upon the Motion (the “**Motion**”) of VALLEY BUILDERS LLC, TRADEMARC ASSOCIATES INC. and DAVID WATKINS HOMES INC., petitioning creditors herein (collectively, the “**Petitioning Creditors**”) for an order (i) directing the immediate appointment of a chapter 11 trustee for TOUGH MUDDER INCORPORATED and TOUGH MUDDER EVENT PRODUCTION INCORPORATED, and (ii) scheduling a hearing to consider the relief sought in the Motion; and after due deliberation; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor; it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Motion is granted; and it is further

ORDERED, that the United States Trustee shall promptly appoint a Chapter 11 Trustee in the captioned involuntary chapter 11 cases.

ORDERED, that the Chapter 11 Trustee shall manage the operations of the Alleged Debtors and develop a restructuring or sale strategy, whichever is in the best interests of the creditors of the Alleged Debtors.

ORDERED, that the Chapter 11 Trustee may negotiate a sale of the Alleged Debtors' assets, subject to Court approval and higher and better offers.
